Two gems from today's word of God have found their way into the eucharistic prayers of the Roman Missal. One is from Moses' address to the Israelites at Mt Sinai, when he tells them they are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation and God's

own people. Adopted by Peter in his first letter and applied to Christian believers, it is the centrepiece of the first preface for Sundays in Ordinary Time.

The other is Jesus' revelation to his disciples that he is the Way, the Truth and the Life. This terse text has been expanded for one of the prefaces of the Eucharistic Prayer for Special Needs and Occasions. Within this prayer addressed to the Father, it speaks of Jesus as "the way that leads to you, the truth that sets us free, the life that fills us with gladness".

The two texts illuminate each other. The more we wonder at the beauty and wisdom of Jesus, the more we see the grace and goodness of God at work in us. We have indeed been set apart to sing the praises of God who called us out of darkness into his wonderful light. **Source: Liturgy Brisbane**

Join us for this year's 'Walk with Christ' annual Eucharistic Procession through the streets of Sydney to make a joyful public proclamation and act of worship towards the person of Jesus Christ (as King), and to invoke His blessing upon the city.

The presence of the Eucharist in this joyful liturgical act invokes the benevolent spiritual blessings of Christ onto the city and all who live there. The blessing is derived from He who has been "anointed to proclaim the good news to the poor ...to proclaim freedom for prisoners and sight to the blind, to set the oppressed free, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favour." It is in this way that the Walk with Christ is part of the spiritual and civic life of the city and Catholic Archdiocese of Sydney.

SAFEGUARDING UPDATE

It is important that all volunteers in the Parish should be aware of their Safeguarding requirements. Volunteers that require special training include the following:

Acolytes, Readers, Special Ministers of the Eucharist, Wardens – those who take up the collection on a Sunday.

Part of the requirements include completing Safeguarding and Child Protection training. The good news is the Archdiocese is organising zoom training next Friday 12 May from 9am to 10am (usually takes about ½ hour) for those volunteers who have not completed the induction training. This is highly encouraged as this is a lot easier that going online and reading all the information before answering the questions along the way. As this is a compulsory requirement of the above Volunteer work, if anyone has not done the original induction training please register and attend your zoom next Friday. You will receive a certificate which a copy must be sent to the Parish Office.
