

We only hear the beginning and end of Paul's pain-ridden effort in Romans to make sense of his own people's unbelief in Christ. Here are a few things that biblical scholar N.T. Wright has to say about chapters 9–11. "[It] is one of the most careful and sustained arguments anywhere

in Paul's letters. . . At the vital point he insists, as he had done in synagogues from Antioch to Corinth, that the goal of the Torah, the aim and purpose of the whole narrative was the Messiah. . . This, then, is Israel's story, with Israel's Messiah as its climax. It is not, and never can be, a story cut loose from the story of Israel, as Marcion would argue later on and as perhaps some in Rome were already supposing. . . Paul here, we remember, is writing to head off any suggestion in the Roman Church that it's now time for the followers of Jesus to cut loose from their Jewish context and see themselves as simply a Gentile community" (Paul: A Biography, NY: Harper-Collins, 2018, 331-33).



As I mentioned last week, on Tuesday morning our school community joined with Father Jacek and parishioners to celebrate the feast of Australia's first saint, St Mary of the Cross MacKillop. After Mass Father Jacek blessed our new statue of St Mary MacKillop in the school grounds. Thank you to Father Jacek, Mr Geoff Ticehurst and the parents, carers and parishioners who were able to join us for the blessing and a cup of tea. Mrs Karin Webb was able to be with us as a special guest courtesy of her new school. It was most appropriate that Karin could be with us as the statue was the result of one of her initiatives as our Religious Education Coordinator.

Last year St Anne's School participated in an "Inquiry and Review." This is a process that each of the Catholic schools in the Archdiocese go through every five years to reflect on their successes and to plan directions to ensure continuous improvement. On Wednesday and Thursday, I was part of the panel at Sacred Heart Catholic Primary School, Cabramatta as they went this process. I enjoy visiting other schools. It is always an opportunity to pick up some bright ideas. Sacred Heart is a beautiful school with a culturally diverse community. They have just 6 native speakers of English out of 604 students.

Over the last few weeks, I have interviewed some bright sparks for Kinder in 2024. I interviewed a girl whose mother speaks to only in Italian. At the same time the father speaks to the girl only in Polish. However, when the parents speak to each other they use English because the mother doesn't speak Polish and the father doesn't speak Italian. Fortunately, the four-year-old could speak to me in English because I am not strong in Polish or Italian.
